Compulsive Checking Treatment Research

**Do you repeatedly check that items are as they should
be (e.g., stoves, locks)?**

**Do you experience intrusive doubts about whether
these items were properly checked?**

**Do these behaviours and doubts cause distress or
interference in your life?**

If you answered “yes” to any of the above questions, you may be eligible for a **brief, 2-session psychological treatment research study (that requires 5 visits in total)**.

Dr. Gillian Alcolado at the St. Boniface Hospital Anxiety Disorders Clinic is currently conducting a research treatment study on obsessive-compulsive disorder.
